**Narrative:**

On April 25, 2025, at approximately 4:25pm, officers from the Homer Police Department, the Cortland County Sheriff's Office and the New York State Police were dispatched to Hudson Street in the Village for a shots fired /shooting with injuries complaint.

When officers arrived on scene, they located a 44-year-old male victim on the side of the roadway who had an apparent gun shot wound to his upper right leg. The victim was treated at the scene by members of the Homer Fire Department and transported to Upstate Hospital by Tully Ambulance for serious injuries. The victim remains in stable condition at the hospital.

The suspect was observed leaving the scene, west bound on Hudson Street, towards North West Street (Route 281) in a dark colored sports utility vehicle.

This is an ongoing investigation being conducted by the Village of Homer Police Department and assisted by the Cortland County Sheriff's Office and the New York State Police.
